The scenery is spectacular and you will ride and hike in places where nobody has ever been.

Day 1	Pick-up in Fort St. John at noon and driving through Peace Valley to Hudson's Hope. 1-hour boat trip to the lodge.
Day 2	Preparation day We pack our gear and head for Charlie camp where the horses are waiting You will learn how to pack and saddle your horse. We spend the night there.
Day 3	We pack our horses and head for our mountain camp.
Day 4-5	We ride & hike through the mountains from camp site to camp site. The most spectacular view is waiting for you!
Day 6	We leave the mountains early morning and head back to Charlie Camp, where we leave the horses and head back to the lodge. A hot shower and a home-made meal will be waiting for you.
Day 7-8	We pack the boat with our tents and spend he days on the lake fishing, exploring waterfalls and collecting fossils. We camp on the beach for the night.
Day 9:	Back at the lodge for a relaxing day, digesting all the impressions. We might jump in the boat and go fishing for a big lake trout.
Day 10	We leave the lodge and head back to civilization. We expect to be in Fort St. John during the afternoon.
